Introduction:

- 1. Paul's letter to the Ephesians is packed with several descriptions of the church.
- 2. Chapter 2 ends with one such description.
- 3. Ephesians 2:19-21

Discussion:

I. A Kingdom - Citizens

- A. **Ephesians 2:19** "Now therefore you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but *fellow citizens* with the saints...." Citizenship req. kingdom
- B. **Matt. 16:15-19** = the church = the kingdom
- C. **Col. 1:12-14** God conveyed (transferred) us into the kingdom of His Son.
- D. Dan. 2:44-45 kingdom which shall stand forever
- E. We need to be diligent to make our election sure (2 Pt. 1:10-11)

II. A Household

- A. Eph. 2:19b "members of the household of God"
- B. Adopted as sons Eph. 1:3-6.
- C. **John 1:11-13** right to become children, born of God
- D. **Romans 8:14-17** Spirit of adoption -> "Abba, Father"-> children of God -> heirs
- E. Adopted and born into John 3:3,5-8; 1 Pt. 1:23

III. A Building - Foundation

- **A. Ephesians 2:20** build on the foundation of the apostles and prophets
- B. Mt. 16:16-18 the truth, Jesus is the son of God
- C. 1 Cor. 3:10-11 Jesus is the only foundation

IV. A Building - Cornerstone

- A. Ephesians 2:20 Jesus Christ chief cornerstone
- B. 1 Peter 2:4-7 rejected by men, chosen by God
- C. Is. 28:16 precious cornerstone, sure foundation
- **D. Psalm 118:22-24** The stone which the builders rejected

V. A Temple - Dwelling place of God in the Spirit

- **A. Ephesians 2:21-22** the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple
- B. 1 Cor. 3:16-17 we are the holy temple of God
- C. 1 Pt. 2:5 a spiritual house, holy priesthood

Conclusion:

- 1. Since we are part of the Kingdom, we have responsibility to serve God acceptably (**Heb.** 12:28-29)
- 2. We are to uphold the truth of God (1 Tim. 3:14-15)
- 3. If you are not part of the Kingdom, or have been separated from the Kingdom, you need to come to the Kingdom.
