- B. The body = the church (**Eph. 1:22-23; Col. 1:18**)
- C. Jesus promised to build one (**Matt. 16:18**)

V. When He says not everyone that says "Lord, Lord" will be saved

- A. **Matthew 7:21-23** – those who do the will
- B. **Matthew 7:24-27**
- C. **Matthew 7:13-14** – few will make it to heaven

VI. When He says what we need to do to be saved

- A. Hear (Matthew 17:5 – this is my beloved son, hear ye him)
- B. Believe (Romans 10:17; Heb. 11:6)
- C. Repent (Acts 2:38, Lk. 13:3,5)
- D. Confess (Romans 10:9-10; Matt. 10:32)
- E. Be baptized (Mk. 16:16)
- F. Remain Faithful (1 Cor. 15:58; Rev. 2:10)
