- 1. Read James 4:13-17
- 2. Here today, gone tomorrow
 - -Examples of Death
- 3. No Idea what tomorrow may bring Eccl. 9:11-12
- 4. Knowing this ought to change our lives today!

Discussion-

- I. Today, Remember Who Is Really In Control
 - A. Not Me! These men forgot that (James 4:13)
 - 1. They planned for the future and boasted of tomorrow
 - 2. Don't boast, for we are not in control
 - 3. Prov. 16:9 "A man's heart deviseth his way: but the Lord directeth his steps"
- 4. Jeremiah 10:23 "O Lord, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his steps."
- 5. Luke 12:16-21 Rich man had plans, he knew how it would work out --- but had no idea that night his soul would be required.
 - B. God is in control!
 - 1. God who is good, omniscient, omnipotent, omnipresent
 - 2. Luke 12:22-34 fear not, God will take care of you
 - 3. // sermon on the mount Matt. 6:25-34 Do not worry about tomorrow...God is in control!
 - 4. Death is a reminder that God is in control.
- II. Today, Acknowledge the Lord
 - A. James 4:13-17 all these men acknowledged was what they were going to do
 - B. James 4:15 They ought to have said "If the Lord will, we shall live, and do this, or that"
 - C. Proverbs 3:6 "In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths"
 - 1. We may make plans, have goals and ambitions
 - 2. But we need to acknowledge the Lord, place our trust in him Proverbs 3:5
 - 3. Give thanks to God
 - 4. Give glory to God
 - 5. For he is in control!
- III. Today, Live In the Present
 - A. For we do not know what tomorrow may bring Prov. 27:1

- B. Matthew 6:34 Stop worrying about tomorrow
- C. Phil. 3:1-21 This one thing I do
 - 1. What press toward the mark for the prize (:14)
 - 2. How Forgetting those things behind (:13)
 - a. Past accomplishments
 - b. Past failures
 - 3. How Reaching forth unto the things before (:13)
- D. Phil. 1:19-26 to live is Christ, to die is gain (result of living life in the present)
- E. Ephesians 5:15-17 Redeeming the time
- IV. Today, Do What the Lord Wills
 - A. If the Lord wills.... more than something we say
 - 1. It means that I want what the Lord wants!
 - 2. Christ example (39,42,44) Matthew 26:36-46
 - B. Luke 6:46-49 Do what the Lord commands, and you will stand firm!
 - C. Matthew 6:33 Rather than worry, focus on seeking first the Kingdom of God,
 - 1. Then these things will be added unto you!
 - 2. And your will will grow closer to the Lord's will.
- V. Today, Do What Is Right Without Procrastinating
 - A. James 4:17 it is a sin not to do good when you know to
 - B. James 2:15-16 no profit if you don't DO
 - C. Proverbs 3:27-28 don't wait until tomorrow!
 - D. We don't know if we will have another opportunity...
 - 1. To teach others (Mark 16:15-16)
 - 2. To study God's word (2 Tim. 2:15)
 - 3. To be an example (light world/salt earth Mt. 5:13-16)
 - 4. To say an encouraging word (1 Thess. 5:11)
 - 5. To obey the gospel (Acts 22:16)

Conclusion-

- 1. Psalm 144:4 "Man is like to vanity (a breath): his days are as a shadow that passeth away"
- 2. We are all living on "borrowed time" a vanishing vapour
- 3. This ought to change how we live today! (repeat points)
