# I. IT BELONGS TO THE LORD (INSPIRED)

- A. Psalm 119:1
- B. Divine = Of the Lord, of God = from God and not men
- C. Gal. 1:11-12 the gospel is not of man
- D. Verbal inspiration of the word of God
  - 1. 2 Tim. 3:16-17 all scripture given by the inspiration of God...
  - 2. Heb. 1:1-2 Spake in time past by the prophets, these last days by his son
  - 3. "Hear ye the word of the Lord" -- 6x in Jeremiah
  - 4. "Thus saith the Lord" -- 55x in Amos

## II. IT CLEANSES US

- A. Psalm 119:9
- B. John 15:3 Made clean through the words of Christ
- C. 1 Tlm. 5:22 keep thyself pure
- D. 1 Peter 1:22 purify your soul in obeying the truth

## III. IT HELPS US AVOID SIN

- A. Psalm 119:11
- B. Christ is our example of this (Matthew 4) tempted 3 times (1 John 2:16) = 3 times he said "it is written"
- C. We ought to be familiar with the Bible, recall scripture when tempted to avoid sin

## IV. IT STRENGTHENS US

- A. Psalm 119:28
- B. How strong do you consider yourself spiritually?
- C. Eph. 6:10 commanded to be strong in the Lord & in the power of his might
- D. 2 Tim. 2:1 be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus

## V. IT SAVES US

- A. Psalm 119:41
- B. Salvation belongs to the Lord Psalm 3:8
- C. Saved by the name of Christ Acts 4:12
- D. The Gospel is God's power unto salvation Romans 1:16
- E. Confession is made unto salvation Romans 10:10
- F. Salvation by hearing, believing, and then obeying God's word

## VI. IT COMFORTS US

- A. Psalm 119:50
- B. The Bible is a book of great comfort
  - 1. Deut. 33:27 The eternal God is thy refuge, underneath are everlasting arms
  - 2. Psalm 23 oft read at funerals
  - 3. John 14:1-4, 27 Jesus comforts his disciples before departing
  - 4. 2 Cor. 5:1 ; Phil. 1:23
  - 5. Rev. 14:14 blessed are the dead who die in the Lord

#### VII. IT GIVES US HOPE

- A. Psalm 119:74
- B. The Bible is a book of hope
  - 1. Without hope before Christ Eph. 2:12-13
  - 2. We have the hope of the gospel Col. 1:23
  - 3. Hope as an anchor for the soul, sure & steadfast Heb. 6:19
    - a. That keeps us from drifting with the tide Heb. 2:1-4
    - b. That keeps us steadfast and unmovable 1 Cor. 15:58
    - c. Be not moved away from the hope Col. 1:23
  - 4. We must be prepared to give an answer for our hope 1 Pt. 3:15

## VIII. IT IS FAITHFUL

- A. Psalm 119: 86 all they commandments are faithful
- B. You don't have to wonder if God's word is so, it is!
- C. Psalm 119:89 his word is FOREVER settled in heaven
  - 1. No earthly headquarters with the head of the church, in Heaven
  - 2. God's word does not change! (Unlike the creeds of men)
  - 3. We must rightly divide the word though 2 Tim. 2:15

#### IX. IT MAKES US WISE

- A. Psalm 119:98-99
- B. Two groups of people the wise and the foolish
- C. Timothy was wise from his youth up by knowing the scriptures 2 Tim. 3:15; 1:5

## X. IT IS VERY PURE

- A. Psalm 119:140
- B. Suppose I agreed to teach 99.5% truth. Is that good enough? NO!.... you add any amount of error to the truth and you wind up with error.
- C. Add nothing to His word!!!
  - 1. Deut. 4:2 Ye shall not add to / diminish ought from the word of God
  - 2. Prov. 30:6 and thou not unto his words....
  - 3. Rev. 22:18 don't add to / take away from the word

## XI. IT IS TRUE

- A. Psalm 119:142
- B. John 8:32 ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free
- C. John 17:17 the words of God are truth
- D. The scripture are the words of a God that cannot lie Titus 1:2
- E. We must rightly divide the word of truth 2 Tim. 2:15
- F. Psalm 119: 160 every one of thy judgements is true

## XII. IT BRINGS GREAT PEACE

- A. Psalm 119:165
- B. It seems at times there is no peace in the world, but there is in Christ John 16:33
- C. Phil. 4:6-7 we can have the peace of God which passers all understanding
- D. The gospel of peace Eph. 6:15; Romans 10:15
- E. Being justified, we have peace w/ God through our Lord Jesus Christ Romans 5:1-2
