# Be Subject to One Another

#### Introduction:

- 1. Part 7/8 in our series on the book of Ephesians
- 2. Overview of Ephesians series...
- 3. Lesson 6 ended with Ephesians 5:21 "... and be subject to one another in the fear of God"
- 4. The application of verse 21 is the topic of today's lesson
  - a. General principle = maintain the proper subordination in the various relationships of life
  - b. Specific application of those who are to submit:
    - 1. Wives (5:22-24) -> Husbands
    - 2. Children (6:1-3) -> Parents
    - 3. Slaves (6:5-8) -> Masters
  - c. Commands others to use that authority properly don't abuse the power
    - 1. Husbands (5:25-33)
    - 2. Fathers (6:4)
    - 3. Masters (6:9)

#### Discussion:

- ----Husbands & Wives // Christ & the Church [Eph. 5:22-33] ----
  - I. Submission and Headship (Eph. 5:22-24)
    - A. Wives: be subject (submit) to own husbands
      - 1. AS TO THE LORD as you would to the Lord b/c He commanded it
        - a. Col. 3:18 as is fitting in the Lord
        - b. Titus 2:5 so the word of God not dishonored
    - B. Husband is head of the wife
      - 1. There is a divine order 1 Cor. 11:3
      - 2. AS CHRIST ALSO IS THE HEAD OF THE CHURCH
        - a. He has the right to direct/control the church Eph. 1:20-23
        - 3. HE HIMSELF BEING THE SAVIOR OF THE BODY
    - C. AS THE CHURCH IS SUBJECT TO CHRIST
      - 1. Christ has all authority Mt. 28:28; Eph. 1:22-23; Col. 2:9-10
      - 2. So also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything
        - a. In all things not contrary to the word of God (Ac. 4:19) obey God over man (even husband)
          - 1. However, an unbelieving husband may be influenced by her submission and reverence for him 1 Pt. 3:1
  - II. Love and Purity (Eph. 5:25-28)
    - A. Husbands, love your wives
      - 1. This authority cannot be without love Col. 3:19; 1 Pt. 3:7

- 2. JUST AS CHRIST LOVED THE CHURCH AND GAVE HIMSELF FOR IT
  - a. The greatest example of love Jn. 15:12-13
- 3. So THAT HE MIGHT SANCTIFY HER.....
  - a. Cleansed her... // b/w a virgin purified/prepared for her husband 2 Cor. 11:2-4
  - b. SANCTIFIED BY THE WASHING OF WATER W/ THE WORD sanctified by truth **Jn. 17:17**
  - c. THAT HE MIGHT PRESENT IT TO HIMSELF A GLORIOUS CHURCH W/O SPOT...HOLY& BLAMELESS Col. 1:21-23; Eph. 1:3-4
- III. Membership and Unity (Eph. 5:28-33)
  - A. Husbands love their own wives
  - B. AS THEIR OWN BODY the same love and care he has for himself!
    - 1. HE WHO LOVES HIS OWN WIFE LOVES HIMSELF... NOURISH/CHERISH IT
    - 2. Just as Christ also does the church, b/c we are members of His body the love of Christ as we are his body!
    - 3. <u>Leave father/mother, joined to wife = one flesh</u> (:31 c.f. :29)
    - C. mystery is great, but I'm speaking w/ ref. to Christ and the church
      - 1. The similarities between marriage and Christ & the church and the closeness of the relationship with Christ was not obvious
    - D. Nevertheless, each individual among you also is to love his own wife...
      - 1. Paul goes back to his original discussion of submission and proper authority b/w wife and husband

Children and Pa	rents [Eph. 6:1-4] -	

- IV. Children Obey your Parents
  - A. Obey your parents in the Lord
    - 1. Obedience = submission
    - 2. In the Lord = as the lord commands, and only so far as the commands agree with God
  - B. FOR THIS IS RIGHT
    - 1. Because God commanded it and it pleases Him Col. 3:20
  - C. <u>Honor your father and mother</u>
    - 1. It goes beyond just an obedience, requires respect, value
  - D. 1ST COMMANDMENT WITH A PROMISE EX. 20:12; DEUT. 5:16
- V. <u>Fathers, Don't provoke your children</u>
  - A. Don't discourage them! Col. 3:21
  - B. But bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord
    - 1. **Gen. 18:19**; Abraham, command children keep the way
    - 2. **Deut. 6:6-9**; diligently teach your children
    - 3. **Prov. 22:6**; train up a child in the way he should go
    - 4. **2 Tim. 1:5, 3:15**; Timothy's good upbringing

----- Slaves and Masters [Eph. 6:5-9] ------

### VI. Slaves be obedient to your masters

- A. Obedience = submission and reverence
- B. With fear and trembling <-> reverence
- C. IN SINCERITY OF HEART, AS TO CHRIST
  - 1. As if you were serving Christ
  - 2. RENDER SERVICE WITH GOODWILL 1 Tim. 6:1-2; 1 Pt. 2:18-20
  - 3. AS TO THE LORD, NOT MEN **Col. 3:22-24**
- D. KNOWING THAT WHATEVER GOOD ONE DOES, HE WILL RECEIVE BACK FROM THE LORD Matt. 16:27; 2 Cor. 5:10-11

## VII. <u>Masters do the same to them</u>

- A. Give up threatening Don't abuse your power!
- B. KNOWING THAT BOTH THEIR MASTER AND YOURS IS IN HEAVEN
  - 1. Slave or master, both serve God, our master Col. 3:25
  - 2. NO PARTIALITY WITH HIM
    - a. **Deut. 10:17** shows no partiality, takes no bribe
    - b. **Ac. 10:34-35** everyone who obeys is accepted

### Conclusion:

- 1. No matter our earthly relationships, we need to understand and practice the proper submission in them. If we are the one with authority, we must wield it responsibly.
- 2. We learn much about the relationship of Christ and the church by looking at the similarities between husband and wife.
- 3. Just as wife is in submission to her husband, the christian is subject to his head, Christ and is to be in submission
- 4. Won't you submit to the Lord today?
