- 1. The New Testament emphasized the need of Christians to be reminded.
- 2. Consider the words of Peter in 2 Peter 3
- 3. 2 Peter 3:1-4 "stir up your pure minds by way of reminder"
- 4. 2 Peter 3:17-18 "since you know this beforehand"

Discussion: "What are the benefits of reminders?"

I. CAUSE US TO BEWARE

- A. **2 Pt. 3:17** beware
- B. (Heb. 3:7-15) beware of an evil heart of unbelief and the deceitfulness of sin like the rebellion of Israel, don't harden your hearts
- C. (1 Pt. 5:8) reminders help us to be watchful for the devil
- D. (Mark 8:15) "Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees" error stands out when we are mindful of scripture

II. CAUSE US TO RECOGNIZE THE POWER OF ERROR

- A. **2 Pt. 3:17** "being led away by the error of the wicked"
- B. (1 Timothy 1:18-20) some have rejected and suffered shipwreck concerning the faith (put away KJV; thrust from them made shipwreck ASV)
- C. (2 Pt. 2:1-3) false teachers who will secretly bring destructive heresies many will follow their ways
- D. (2 Timothy 2:16-18) increase to more ungodliness, their message will spread like cancer
- E. (Book of Jude) contend earnestly for the faith (:3-4)
 - 1. This is nothing new (:5-11)
 - 2. They are clouds w/o water, raging waves (:12-15)
 - 3. Remember the warnings of the Apostles (:16-19)
 - 4. God is able to build/keep us from stumbling (:20-25)

III.CAUSE US TO WATCH FOR A FALL FROM STEADFASTNESS

- A. 2 Pt. 3:17 "lest you also fall from your own steadfastness"
- B. (1 Cor. 10:1-12) remember the example of Israel and make sure that we don't fall like they did by forgetting God
- C. (Heb. 6:4-6) fall away and crucify again the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame

IV.CAUSE US TO GO BACK TO THE STANDARD OF AUTHORITY

- A. 2 Pt. 3:18 "grow in grace and knowledge of our Lord..."
- B. **2 Pt. 3:1-4** "that you may be mindful of the words spoken before by the holy prophets... and the commandments of the apostles"
- C. (1 Pt. 1:22-25) born again by the word of God this word by which the Apostles preached
- D. (1 Pt. 4:11) if ANYONE speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. Don't turn aside to 'another' Gospel (Gal. 1:6-9)

- E. (2 Pt. 1:2-4, 12-21) The apostles and prophets spoke the inspired word of God this is our standard of authority
- F. (2 Timothy 3:14-17) grounded in the inspired word of God

Conclusion:

- 1. Let us understand the value of reminders and be reminded of God's Word
- 2. Reminders cause us to:
 - a. Beware
 - b. Recognize the Power of Error
 - c. Watch for a fall from our steadfastness
 - d. Return to the Standard of Authority
- 3. Let us continue to grow in grace and knowledge () and recognize the value of being reminded.
