- 2. We are commanded to understand Eph. 5:17; Col. 1:9-10
- 3. God's word is written so that we can understand Eph. 3:3-5
- It is vital that we come to the correct understanding of scripture Rom. 1:16;
 1:18-25
- 5. What are some things which will help us to understand god's word?

Discussion:

I. EXPECT TO UNDERSTAND

- A. If we do not have an expectation of understanding, we will prevent ourselves before beginning.
- B. The scriptures claim to be understandable Eph. 3:1-9
- C. Scripture is God's words to man which can be understood 1 Cor. 2:6-13. And understood alike by all (Rom. 15:4-6)
- D. Scripture is addressed to all (1 Thess. 5:27; Col. 4:16), even to the 'common' man 1 Cor. 1:26-31

II. HAVE FAITH IN THE INSPIRATION

- A. Holy Scripture is God-breathed **2 Tim. 3:15-17**. Being the product of God it is profitable. If just the words of men, then scripture is of no value.
- B. NO prophecy of scripture originated with man 2 Pt. 1:19-21
- C. God spoke first through the prophets, then through His son **Heb. 1:1-3**
- D. The scriptures are God's commandments 1 Cor. 14:36-38

III.DESIRE TO KNOW AND DO GOD'S WILL

- A. If we don't approach God's word with a desire to obey, it is not likely we will understand, and we will not benefit from study.
- B. We are to understand the will of the Lord **Eph. 5:17**, this is NOT just an intellectual pursuit
- C. If we hear, but fail to obey God's word, it has no benefit in our life and we will not receive salvation Lk. 6:46-49; Mt. 7:21-23; James 1:22-25
- D. Must have a will to do His will (some claim to want salvation but fail to come to Christ)
 Jn. 5:39-40; 7:14-19 (A willingness to do His will found in scripture is what prepares our mind for the effort required to understand it)

IV.HAVE SPIRITUAL PURITY

- A. God's word is that which sanctifies, or sets apart, the believer from the world Jn. 17:13-19
- B. Called to lay aside filthiness and lust of this world that we may receive the word James 1:21, 26; 1 Pt. 2:1-3

C. Love for the world blinds us from the truth – 1 Jn. 2:15; Jn. 5:44, 8:42-44; 2 Thess. 2:8-12; 2 Cor. 4:3-4; 1 Cor. 2:13-14

V. USE MENTAL INDUSTRY

- A. Though God's word is accessible and can be understood it requires a great deal of mental industry (concerted effort)
- B. Need the mindset of the Bereans readiness of mind, searched the scriptures daily Acts 17:2-3, 11-12
- C. Continual reading, meditation, and study required Ps. 1:1-2; Acts 17:26-27; 1 Tim. 4:13-16; 2 Tim. 2:15;
- D. Reason of use, have our senses exercised Heb. 5:12-14
- E. when this effort is not employed, we twist the scriptures to our destruction 2 Pt. 3:14-18

VI. SEEK GOD'S BLESSINGS

- A. The goal of our pursuit of understanding must be to abide in Christ, otherwise not of it will matter Jn. 15:1-8
- B. Once we study to know God's word, we should seek wisdom from God, knowing He will provide Js. 1:5; Matt. 7:7-11
- C. Put the whole armor of God and pray Eph. 6:14-15

Conclusion:

- 1. God has told us that we MUST understand His will.
- 2. God has shown us that we CAN understand His will.
